### NEW MEXICO JUNIOR HIGH RODEO REQUIREMENTS FOR MEMBERSHIP:

#### THE FOLLOWING FORMS MUST BE MAILED TO: NMJHRA, 1668 S RR 3, PORTALES, NM 88130

1. Printed Copy of National Junior High Rodeo Association Membership Application 2019-2020
  2. Printed Copy of National Junior High Rodeo Association Minor's Release (Notarized)
  3. Current Grade Report (end of last school year) – EVERYONE MUST SUBMIT GRADES!!!
  4. Eligibility Form (signed by the school administration you are enrolled in for the current school year)
  5. NMJHRA Medical Release Form
  6. Concussion Form
  7. Concussion Certificate
  8. Physical (completed after April 1, 2019)
  9. Competing Membership Fee: \$130.00 (due with application)
- All membership applications, forms, and fees listed above **must be received two weeks prior to the closing date of the first rodeo** you plan to enter. Membership forms that are missing signatures, fees, or not filled out correctly will be returned and not accepted. All forms must be completed, signed and notarized, then uploaded to the National Member Portal and mailed to NMJHRA.
  - **Parents:** Both parents/legal guardians are required to sign all forms! If only one parent is signing, it needs to be noted the situation. For example: deceased or divorced-sole custody.
  - **Grade Report: ALL MEMBERS** must submit a current grade report signed by the school official and an eligibility form signed by the school official. Grade Reports need to be uploaded into the National Member Portal. Grade reports and eligibility forms must be mailed to NMJHRA.
  - **NMJHRA MEDICAL RELEASE, CONCUSSION FORM, AND CONCUSSION CERTIFICATE** – Links for these pages can be found on the NMJHRA Membership page. These forms must be mailed to NMJHRA.
  - **Physical:** Physical must be completed by a doctor after April 1, 2019. A copy of the physical must be mailed

to NMHSRA.

- **Fees:** Check or money order made payable to: New Mexico Junior High Rodeo Association for \$130.
- **I CAN NOT PROCESS YOUR MEMBERSHIP UNTIL I HAVE RECEIVED YOUR DUES, YOU HAVE UPLOADED YOUR 3 SIGNED & NOTARIZED FORMS AND YOUR CURRENT GRADES TO THE NATIONAL MEMBER PORTAL!!!**
